Teen Time Camps are operated by Teen Time of Edmonton, a registered charitable, non-profit, non-denominational Christian organization. Teen Time encourages wholesome physical, social, and intellectual activities together with spiritual development in young people through recreational programming, social interactions, and by teaching Scriptural principles. Teen Time's programs and services are available to any young person.

Teen Time began offering summer camps in 1967 at Moose Lake, Alberta. In 1974, land was purchased 120 kilometres north of Edmonton for Teen Time's own camp site. Situated on the shores of Makewin Lake, the camp hosts an attractive two-storey lodge facility and summer cabins on a 350 acre ranch.

Facilities include: Girls and Boys bunk houses, lodge with large kitchen and dining area, washroom facilities and showers, recreation centre, lounge with fireplace, chapel, indoor riding area and barns, paintball course, and a wonderful clean lake with a sandy beach.

## Riding School

This camp offers seven days of training and testing by qualified instructors. Campers have an excellent chance to improve their western riding skills and work towards a Horsemanship Certificate. Training includes classroom studies, handling horses and lots of riding practice!

## Wagon Train

This isn't your typical Teen Time camp! Traveling by covered wagons or horseback, campers will journey through scenic rural Alberta, living like our pioneer ancestors did. Campers will experience cooking over an open fire, diving into the river for a quick dip and sleeping under a blanket of stars.

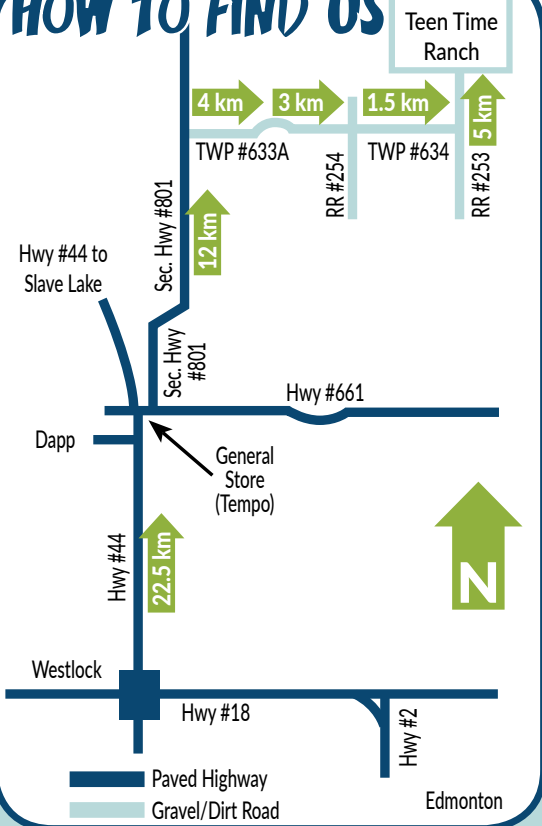
